# VETERANS DAY MONDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2019

How much do you know about The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier?

How many steps does the quard take during his walk across the Tomb of the Unknown and why?

21 steps. It alludes to the twenty-one gun salute, which is the highest honor given any military or foreign dignitary.

How long does he wait after his about face to begin his return walk and why?

21 seconds for the same reason as above.

The Badge, The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier Guard Identification Badge, is the only military badge that can be revoked for any action that brings disrespect to the Tomb during the lifetime of the Tomb Guard.

As of February 2019 there have been only 663 Badges issued and 23 have been revoked.

What are the physical traits of the guard limited to?

For a person to apply for guard duty at the tomb, he must be between 5' 10" and 6' 2" tall and his waist size cannot exceed 30"

The soldier "walking the mat" does not wear rank insignia, so as not to outrank the Unknowns, whatever their ranks may have been.

There are no wrinkles, folds or lint on the uniform. Guards dress for duty in front of a full-length mirror.

The first six months of duty a guard cannot talk to anyone, nor watch TV.

Every guard spends five hours a day getting his uniforms ready for guard duty.

In 2003, as Hurricane Isabelle was approaching Washington DC, it was reported that because of the dangers from the hurricane, the military members assigned the duty of guarding the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier were given permission to suspend the assignment.

They respectfully declined the offer, 'No way, Sir!'

Soaked to the skin, marching in the pelting rain of a tropical storm, they said that guarding the Tomb was not just an assignment, it was the highest honor that can be afforded to a service person. The tomb is patrolled continuously, 24/7.
